

FACTS ABOUT YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARD

- 1.** Upon registering for classes your financial aid will be temporarily applied to your account until the official drop/add period ends. This amount of your financial aid award is listed on the award letter that you receive.
- 2.** Your financial aid will be officially credited to your account the day after the drop/add period ends.
- 3.** Your instructors are required to notify the Registrars' Office if you fail to attend class.
- 4.** If you fail to attend class your financial aid may be adjusted or canceled.
- 5.** Once your attendance in all of the classes that you registered for is verified any money excess financial aid will be mail to you 14 days after the drop/add period ends.
- 6.** If you completely withdraw from the college before 60% of the term has passed you may owe money back to Atlanta Metropolitan College and the U.S. Department of Education.
- 7.** Students who borrow form the Stafford Loan Programs may cancel their students loans within 14 days after the school receive the money from the lender.
- 8.** Parents who borrow for the Plus Loan may cancel the Plus Loan within 14 days after the school receives the money from the Lender.

BOOK STORE and OTHER CHARGES

Students that need to charge books, parking and MARTA passes to their financial aid account must provide an authorization to the college to do so (**this does not include students that were granted a financial aid extension**).

Student may authorize these charges by 'clicking' the Authorization button on the AMC website.
